

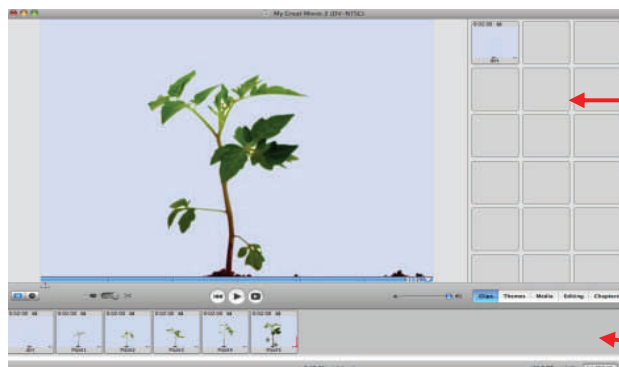
Movie Making Hints and tips



1. Keep your movie short: one or two minutes will do nicely!
2. All good movies have a story.
What is your beginning, middle and end?
3. Do you need to add words to help people understand what the badgers are doing?

WORKING WITH I-MOVIE

To add a clip to your movie, just drag and drop it into your 'timeline'.

To cut part of a movie clip, move the 'playhead' to where you want to cut it, then go to 'EDIT' and 'SPLIT AT PLAYHEAD'. You can then delete the part you don't want.

- To add text, go to the 'EDITING' button, click on 'TITLES' the 'SUBTITLES' then write the text you want in the box. You can 'uncheck' the 'OVER BLACK' button to make sure the text goes directly over your movie. Click 'ADD' when you are finished and watch your movie update itself!
- If you want to create a professional look, add 'TRANSITIONS' between the separate movie clips. Go to 'TRANSITIONS' and select your choice of transition (we recommend 'CROSS DISSOLVE'). Then drag and drop it in between the two slides on your timeline.

Once you are finished, you can play the whole video in full screen mode using this button:



Don't forget to SAVE your movie as you go along!
